performance. Allowing the old fluid to go far beyond this 50,000 mile-mark could create problems within the transmission system, as old transmission fluid becomes thick, sticky and corrosive.

The fluid circulates out of the transmission pan and flows throughout the transmission. Once that the transmission fluid begins to break down, it will not be able to protect the moving parts and seals. Honda recommends changing the Accord transmission fluid around 70,000 miles.

My 2005 Accord owner's manual says to drain, not flush, the fluid. The pressure fro the flush pump may be high enough to damage the solenoids. Get the engine (transmission, actually)

well warmed up and then drain the fluid on a flat surface. You will get at least 70% of the fluid out. Replace the fluid and you are good to go.

Transmission fluid flush vs drain and replace fluid ... If you notice your shifting feels less smooth as it used to you then you may be in need of new transmission fluid. The owner's manual recommends changing the transmission fluid every 120,000 miles or every 8 years, whichever comes first. Under severe conditions the interval is every 60,000 miles or every 4 years.
