The First World War began on July 28, 1914 when Austria-Hungary declared a war against Serbia. It was on June 28, 1914 that Archduke Franz Ferdinand nephew of the Emperor Francis Joseph of Austria-Hungary and heir to Hapsburg throne and his queen were assassinated while on an official visit of Bosnia.

Russia responded with a general mobilization, followed by Austria's ally Germany and Russia's ally France. The first stage of the war quickly escalated, with a general war breaking out between an alliance of Germany and Austria against Russia, France, and Serbia. The war presented the Germans with a special problem.

Battles were fought from trenches resulting in what has been known ever since as trench warfare. Trench warfare prolonged the war: it was fought on the western front from December 1914 to November of 1918. The trenches were surrounded by barbed wire and snipers shot at the enemy if they ventured out.

Staying out of World War I helped President Woodrow Wilson narrowly win re-election in November 1916. But five months later he summoned the country to battle against the German Empire with these words: "The world must be made safe for democracy. ... We have no selfish ends to serve. We desire no conquest, no dominion."
